4th MONDAY OUTINGS

23rd Mar - 8am

Koala Park, Rosemount.
Panorama Dr, Rosemount.

A great 16ha park on the eastern side of Nabour. It's been a while since we visited so let's see if we can see a koala!

Meeting Point: In the car park at 123 Panorama Dr, Rosemount.

27th Apr - 8am

Upper Coochin Creek Environmental Reserve.
Lapwing Circuit, Beerwah.

Reaching from Tower Hill to the west, along Upper Coochin Creek to the Beerwah high school bushlands and train tracks to the east. This remnant old growth & riparian zone can produce over 55 species of birds.

Meeting Point: Lapwing Circuit next to the reserve esplanade.

25th May – 8am

South River Park -East,
South River Dr, Mooloolah Valley

Another 2 years of re-growth since we were last there, it will be interesting to see what species have moved into this area.

Meeting Point: By the playground on South River Dr, Mooloolah.

22nd Jun - 8am

Girraween Reserve, Wallum Lane, Noosa Heads.

Last year's survey was so successful getting 52 bird species and 20 butterflies we hardly got out of the car park, and April's walk provided 45 bird in the rain. Hopefully this time we will make it to the walking track and also spot a glossy black cockatoo.

Meeting Point: Parking is at the end of Wallum Ln, Noosa Heads next to the water treatment plant.

27th Jul – 8am

Mooloolah National Pk, Milieu Pl, Birtinya

A great walk through the eastern section of the Mooloolah National Pk. Mainly on boardwalks through the mangroves and wallum.

Meeting Point: Parking is located at the end of Milieu Pl.
