4th MONDAY OUTINGS

27th Jul – 8am

Mooloolah National Pk, Milieu Pl, Birtinya

A great walk through the eastern section of the Mooloolah National Pk. Mainly on boardwalks through the mangroves and wallum.

Meeting Point: Parking is located at the end of Milieu Pl.

28th Sep – 8am

Isabel Jordan Bushland Reserve, Pathfinder Drv, Caloundra West

One of the last coastal heath areas on the coast, we will look at this and the surrounding area.

Meeting Point: Parking around Pathfinder Drv, Caloundra West.

26th Oct – 8am

South River Park -East, South River Dr, Mooloolah Valley

Another 2 years of re-growth since we were last there, it will be interesting to see how this area is progressing.

Meeting Point: By the playground on South River Dr, Mooloolah.

23rd Nov - 8am

Upper Coochin Creek Environmental Reserve, Caralan Way, Beerwah.

Reaching from Tower Hill to the west, along Upper Coochin Creek to the Beerwah high school bushlands and train tracks to the east. This remnant old growth & riparian zone can produce over 55 species of birds.

Meeting Point: Note different meeting point to previous surveys - Corner of Caralan Way/Emma Plc next to Caralan Way Park.
