### 19<sup>th</sup> Apr – 8am \*Note: 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday Foote Sanctuary, Buderim.

Named in honour of WW1 soldier and Military Medal recipient Eric Foote this 10ha sanctuary was donated to the people of the Sunshine Coast in 1963. It contains a great mix of soil and vegetation types as the reserve drops down Buderim hill resulting in a variety of fauna and fauna.
