## 4<sup>th</sup> MONDAY OUTINGS

### 27<sup>th</sup> Sep – 8am Emu Mountain, Coolum.

This is a really good walk through coastal wallum in the Noosa National Park. If we don't see a Peregrine Falcon we should at least see some endemic flora.

**Meeting Point:** Parking is at the end of Havana Rd East (access from David Low Way), next to Coolum State School.

### 29<sup>th</sup> Oct - 8am Bobbie Sattler Nature Refuge.

The Sattler name is famous on the coast so it is time to have a quick look at the land that was left as a nature refuge by the family.

**Meeting Point:** Parking is on the North West Corner of Fred Chaplin Circuit in Corbould Pk.

### 25<sup>th</sup> Nov - 8am Jill Chamberlain Reserve, Caloundra.

This 31 hectare bushland reserve has a great mix of Eucalyptus species including flooded gum, blackbutt and ironbark. With Allocasuarina also on the site hopefully we will get to see a glossy black cockatoo.

**Meeting Point:** Starting point is at the corner of Winchester Rd and Oakwood St, Caloundra.
