4th MONDAY OUTINGS

26th Feb - 8am

Ben Bennett Park - Queens St, Caloundra

Let's start the year in one of the most easterly conservation areas in the Sunshine Coast. A mix of eucalypt and melaleuca forest give refuge to a variety of species within an urban environment.

Meeting Point: The car parking bay is on Queen St., 300 metres west of the high school.

25th Mar - 8am

Jill Chamberlain Reserve, Caloundra

This 31 hectare bushland reserve has a great mix of eucalyptus species including flooded gum, blackbutt and ironbark. With Allocasuarina also on the site hopefully we will get to see a glossy black cockatoo.

Meeting Point: Starting point is at the corner of Winchester Rd and Oakwood St, Caloundra.

22th Apr - 8am

Meridan Environmental Res., Landsborough

Next to Meridan Hill this circuit includes wet and dry sclerophyll forest along the creek line before changing to more open woodland.

Meeting Point: From Steve Irwin Way turn into Old Caloundra Rd and drive 800m to Hapgood Rd. Turn right and parking will be at 120m.

27rd May – 8am

Lamerough Creekside Walk, Pelican Waters

With a mix of paperbark and eucalypt along this riparian walk it should provide a good mix of fauna species, and is interesting to see what is present along the eastern side of the Aura reserve and Blackbutt forest.

Meeting Point: Park at the northern end of Tweddell Dr (type in 100 Tweedell Drv, Pelican Waters into your navigator.

24th Jun - 8am

Blackbutt Forest, Aura

Interesting old forest on coast. We have currently ID'ed 130 species here including 90 birds.

Meeting Point: Meet in the car park next to the playground and dog park towards the end of Eden Drv, Aura.
