### Hawthorn Park, Marcus Beach

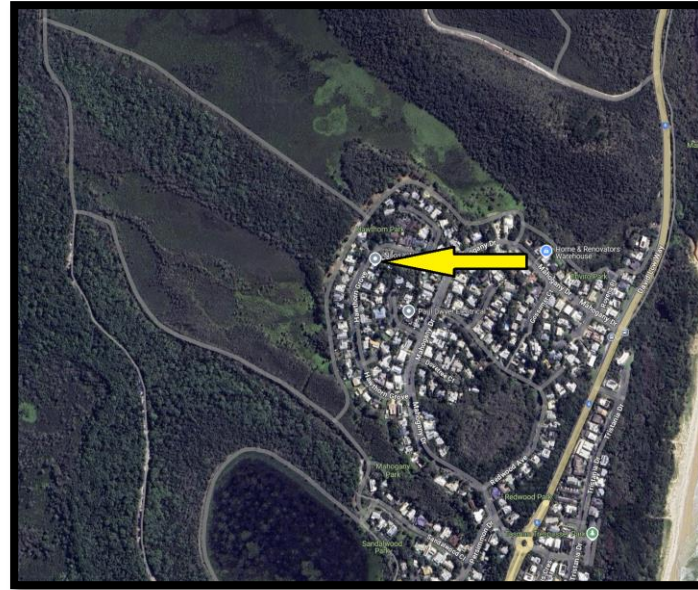
**Meeting Point:** Type in '45 Hawthorn Grove, Marcus Beach' into your navigator and this will lead you just next to Hawthorn Park.
